CROCOSMIA:

Description: Gorgeous sprays of red or orange tubular flowers reaching 2-3 feet with sword like foliage.

Location: Sunny area in well drained soil. Improve soil with peat moss and compost. Also add super phosphate.

Plant: 4” deep and 6-8” apart. Water well.

Flowering Time: July – September

After Care: Either lift corms and store or mulch heavily.

FREESIA:

Description: These very fragrant fans of trumpet shaped flowers come in white, yellow, gold, orange, pink, red, purple and violet and reaches 10-18” tall. Freesia corms can be planted and easily grown indoors. They make excellent cut flowers.

Locations: Sunny or part shade in well drained soil, peat moss and compost should be added.

Plant: 2” deep and 2” apart. For best results, plant in groups of 10-12

Flowering Time: July and August.

After Care: Carefully dig up and store in a cool place over winter.
