

# New Guinea Impatiens

## Outdoors

These wonderful bright colored flowers are an excellent brightener for those shady nooks in your garden.

Protect these plants from the hot sun and from harsh winds.

Water thoroughly, then let the soil go “reasonably” dry, never allowing them to dry out completely. Fertilize every two to three weeks with a good quality high phosphorous fertilizer

## Indoors

Place impatiens in a warm and sunny window and keep the soil moist. Not constantly wet. Never let the plant sit in water.

Fertilize every two to three weeks.

Keep the plant root bound for constant flowering. Repot, if necessary in Spring.
